

## LFYS Program ACT Test Student Resources

1. ACT Practice Books
  - a. Several titles may be checked out from the office. Sign in sheet is kept in the office. Students must check out from the staff and return before checking out a new title.
2. BHS Classes
  - a. ACT Prep-(1 Semester) No Prerequisites 10<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> Grade  
This course is designed to assist students preparing for the ACT assessment test. The English portion will focus on the study and review of the elements of standard written English. The student will learn rhetorical skills and reading skills. The math portion will concentrate on algebra, geometry, and basic trigonometric processes. Students will practice problem-solving skills such as reading, drawing diagrams, analyzing data, and drawing conclusions.
  - b. Online-Online ACT Prep Courses available through the counselor. Independently done for no credit. 2 Courses in English, 2 in Math, 2 in Reading, 1 in Science, and 1 in Writing are available.
3. TCTC Classes
  - a. Classes are held the week prior to the ACT Test Dates. They are one day classes for each subject test.
  - b. The cost is \$25/class/student and the student can enroll in all subjects or just the ones they need additional help in. Enrollment can be done online, in person, or over the phone. Payment is due at time of enrollment.
  - c. Contact LFYS Program about cost before registering for this option.
